decade under the aegis of former marine harold hayes esquire helped turn journalists editors and photographers like tom wolfe gay talese raymond carver michael herr john berendt and diane arbus into celebrities in their own right polsgrove s brilliant book often resembling an esquire cover story offers a warts and all portrait of hayes afterword by ben bagdikian
